Maths

We will be looking at addition and subtraction using the 'Part-Whole' model. They will also use mathematical language to solve problems. They will learn to count forwards and backwards from a given number to 100 and beyond and count in steps of 2, 5 and 10. They will continue to explore the fact families (number bonds) to 10.

English

In literacy we will be focusing on Traditional Tales. We will be exploring the story 'Little Red Riding hood'. The children will learn about what makes a good story and retelling them as well as writing a character description of the wolf.



Topic- Our School

The children will explore their local area by creating and following maps. They will use geographic and historical vocabulary to describe their surroundings, including the school, and discuss how the area has changed over time.



Science - Celebrations

In science, we will explore the concepts of light and dark. The children will investigate the physical properties of different everyday materials and discover various light sources. They will also learn how shadows are formed and will use scientific vocabulary to describe and explain their findings.

Computing

We will be learning to log on and use Purple Mash. The children will learn about collecting data and interpreting pictograms.
