


Maths

We will be looking at Place Value. They will also use mathematical language to solve addition and subtraction problems. They will learn to count forwards and backwards from a given number to 100 and beyond and count in steps of 2,5,10.

English

In literacy we will be focusing on Stories from other cultures. We will be exploring the story 'Nimesh the Adventurer' and 'Thank You Omu'. The children will learn about what makes a good adventure story and will create their own adventure stories and recipes inspired by Omu.



Topic- Our Capital City

Big Question: What is it like to live in London?



The children will be learning about Our Capital City. We will use geographic and historical vocabulary to describe London and talk about how it has changed over time. The children will also learn about the UK and the countries within it.

Religious Education (Judaism)

Big Question: What is it like to live as a Jewish person?



PHSE: Dreams and Goals

The children will be learning about setting goals. Children will be able to:
 -Set a goal and work out how to achieve it
 -How to work well with a partner/ small group to achieve their goals
 -Tackle a new challenge and understand this might stretch my learning

Music



The class will be singing songs with the Music Teacher and learn to play the African drums. They will learn about rhythm.

Physical Education - Judo

Our PE day will be every Friday. Please ensure that your child has a PE Kit, (white t-shirt, shorts or joggers, sensible running shoes).

Science- Polar Adventure

In science, we will be learning to name animals that are birds, fish and mammals. To name common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. To describe and compare different common animals. They will identify and classify different materials and animals. The children will ask questions and answer them in different ways, observing ice activities closely. They will perform simple tests to test their ideas.



Computing

We will be learning to follow and create simple instructions on the computer. They will explore algorithm -a step-by-step set of instructions used to solve a problem or achieve an objective.

Cooking and Nutrition (CaN) - Tuesdays!

We will be cooking what is in season and rustling up dishes in addition to challenging ourselves to use up store cupboard staples. The children will be learning cutting, peeling, mashing and learning the importance of food hygiene.
