

Maths

Our unit will be Multiplication and Division. The children will learn how to count in steps of 2, 5 and 10. They will be counting objects in groups of 2s, 5s and 10s and relating it to their division facts. They will relate this to their timetables and recall their timetables facts with increasing fluency.



English

We will be exploring the features of a recount. We will be learning about the life cycle of a butterfly and writing our own recount on this.

Big Question: Where does food come from?



We will be exploring different fruit and vegetables all over the world. We will also be looking at how these are grown by farmers and sold to the markets. We will be identifying seasonal weather patterns. We will be planting cress and observing how plants grow.

Music

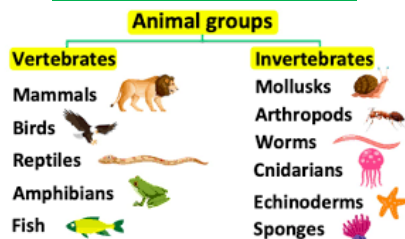


The class will be singing songs with the Music Teacher Mr Bruce and learn to play the African drums with Mr Michael.
