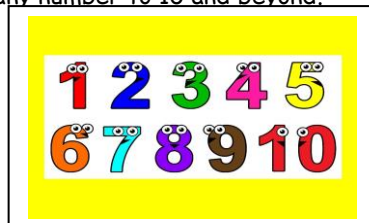
**September/October 2020**

Maths

To count, read and write forwards and backwards from any number to 10 and beyond.  
 To count one more and one less than a number.  
 To compare numbers using language such as equal, more/greater, less/fewer.

Outcomes: Children will be able to:

- Write numbers using the correct number formation.
- Say what number comes before/after a given number.
- Use the correct vocabulary to describe numbers.



Literacy

To know how to use lists, labels and captions.  
 To explore stories in familiar settings.  
 To be able to use full stops and capital letters correctly.

- Outcomes: Children will be able to:
- Use adjectives to describe a character.
  - Retell stories with similar experiences to themselves.
  - Create an exciting story using the key features of the text type



Topic

Over the next 7 weeks we will be following a unit of work on a theme that focuses on "Celebrations". During this unit we will be focusing on **History, Art and society**.

In History, we'll be:

- Exploring how some historical events are celebrated in this day.
- Use the correct vocabulary to describe some celebrations.
- Find answers to questions by using past sources (photos, videos etc).

In Art, we'll be:

- Creating collages of how different celebrations are represented.
- Using different materials to draw particular aspects of different celebrations.

In Society, we'll be:

- Finding out how other people celebrate their own traditions and religions.
- Compare different celebrations.
