# November/December 2024

#### Maths - Addition/Subtraction

Learn to understand how the column method works.
Understand why we need to exchange in adding and subtracting



#### Multiplication/Division

# Outcomes: Children will be able to:

- -Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.
- -Write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables that they know, including for two-digit numbers times one digit numbers, using mental and progressing to formal written methods.
- -Write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division.
- -Solve problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and division.

## TOPIC - History

Over the next 7 weeks we will be following a unit of History work on a theme that focuses on "The Vikings". Our key question is 'Who are the Vikings and why have they gained such a bad reputation?'

### We will be learning about

- Viking homes and settlements
- Viking longboats
- We will be using a range of sources to understand what life was like in a Viking community.
- We will also be looking at the Viking raid on the Monastery in Lindisfarne and how that shaped different perspective on Viking reputation.

#### In D&T, we'll be:

• Creating our own Viking shield.

## Science - The Human Body

We will be looking closely at the Human body and why it fascinates us. Outcome:

- To sort animals by what they eat (carnivore, herbivore and omnivore)
- To learn about the 3 skeleton types and label human skeleton.
- Recreate different movements (muscle) of the human body.
- Explore the digestive system.

# English - Non-Chronological Report

To know how to use headings and subheadings in an information text.

To organise their work into specific information

Start to understand what performance poetry is

Write and perform their own poems

### Outcomes:

Children will be able to create an information leaflet on food. They will include factual information as well as pictures on healthy eating.

Children will start to think about using actions/sounds and rhythm in poetry

Outcomes: Children will be able to:
