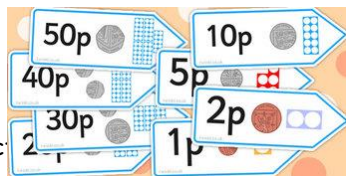


Half-Termly Curriculum Overview for Year 3

Maths - Addition/Subtraction



To use base ten and counters to add and subtract
Learn to understand how the column method works.
Understand why we need to exchange in adding and subtract
Estimate and check answers.

Outcomes: Children will be able to:

- Use the column method to add and subtract 3 digit numbers.
- Start to use correct mathematical vocabulary when solving maths number problems.
- Can see that adding is the inverse of subtraction.

English

To know how to use headings and sub-headings in an information text.
To organise their work into specific information
Start to understand what performance poetry is
Write and perform their own poems

Outcomes:

- Children will be able to create an information leaflet on food. They will include factual information as well as pictures on healthy eating.
- Children will start to think about using actions/sounds and rhythm in poetry

TOPIC

Over the next seven weeks we will be following a unit of work on a theme that focuses on "The Vikings". During this unit we will be focusing on **History, Geography and D&T**.

In History, we'll be:

- Learning about Viking homes and longboats
- In particular we will be looking at
- We will be using a range of sources to understand what life was like.

In Geography, we'll be:

- Investigating Viking invasion and settlement on a world map
- Learning about the land that Vikings lived in eg farms

In D&T, we'll be:

- Creating our own Viking weapon/longboat

PHSE - Celebrating Differences

To know that we are all different

Outcomes: Children will be able to:

- Talk about how to resolve conflicts within families.
- To think what bullying means and how they can stop bullies.

French

In French we will be learning how to say colours, where they live, names of food and weather.



Computing

We will be learning about online safety.

Religious Education

We will be exploring the key question: has Christmas lost its true meaning?

Outcomes: Children will be able to:

- Think what Christmas means to them
- Discuss how Christians celebrate Christmas and what it means to them.
- Find out about the non-Christian aspects of Christmas.

Physical Education - Judo/Games

Outcomes: Children will be able to learn the different Skills required for games such as basketball, tag etc. They will also learn skills needed in Judo.

PE kit bring in every Wednesday and Tuesday

Music

The whole class will be doing singing with Mr Daggett every week. They will be learning how to read music as well as learn to sing a range of songs. We also do drumming on Thursdays.

Science - The Human Body

We will be looking closely at the Human body and why it fascinates us.

Outcome:

- To sort animals by what they eat (carnivore, herbivore and omnivore)
- To learn about the 3 skeleton types and label human skeleton.
- Recreate different movements (muscle) of the human body.
- Explore the digestive system.

Reading - Children are expected to read their school library book at home each night and bring it into school each day. Please read with your child and discuss what you read.
