Autumn Term

September/October 2024

<u>Maths</u>

To understand how to read and write Roman numerals

To understand place value of numbers up to 100,000.

To round numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000.

To add and subtract numbers up to 6 digits.

To use graphs and charts to interpret data.

Outcomes: Children will be able to:

Accurately round numbers of up to 6 digits to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000. They will also be able to analyse and input data using tables, pie charts and bar graphs.

English

To identify the features of a genre/text type - myths & legends / narratives To use basic punctuation appropriately.

To use a dictionary and thesaurus to build and grow their vocabulary.

Outcomes: Children will be able to:

Write a myth/legend using the class text 'The Adventures of Odysseus' using the teatures specific to narrative and legends.

Produce texts using punctuation and grammar mostly correctly. They will use vocabulary to enhance the meaning of the text.

Topic - How can we find out about the civilisation of Ancient Greece?

This half term, Year 5 will be focussing on the topic 'Ancient Greece' and in During this unit we will be focusing on: **History and Art**.

In History, we'll be finding out:

All about the Ancient Greek civilisation as well as learning how the Ancient Greek language has influenced modern day language.

In Art, we'll be finding out:

About different techniques artists use when making pottery and the stories they depict.



Science - Out of this World

In this topic, children learn about space. Starting with the Solar System, they look next at how ideas about space have changed over time, before finally exploring what causes us to experience night and day on Earth.

Year 5 - Ancient Greece

PHSE - Being in my World

<u>Outcomes</u>: Children will be exploring their role in society and considering what it is to be them. They will think about how to control their emotional state in different circumstances.

Computing

Coding - we will be learning how to create simple games using algorithms as well as 'debugging' code that does not run properly.

Religious Education - The Miracles of Jesus

What do the miracles tell us about Jesus?

Outcomes: Children will be able to:

Learn about the different miracles of Jesus and what they teach us about his role in the New Testament and Christianity.

Children will develop their judo skills - building core strength and developing their technique and strategy.
