Numeracy

This term in Numeracy we're focusing on data handling (graphs), ratio and proportion, word problems and investigations – as well as preparing for the SATs

Outcomes: Children will be able to:

Use all four operations to answer multi-step word problems. Interpret and create different charts (including bar charts, line graphs and pie charts)

Find the mean, mode, median and range of a set of data. Solve an investigation by working systematically and collaboratively.

Literacy

This term in Literacy, after focusing initially on the SATS tests, we will be starting a new guided reading book 'The London Eye Mystery' . We will be focusing on journalistic writing, narrative writing and writing in different registers.
