# CURRICULUM OVERVIEW FOR YEAR 'T — AUTUMN TERM |

#### Maths - Place Value

This term, pupils will consolidate their understanding of place value, including reading, writing, and comparing numbers up to 10,000. They will then apply this knowledge to develop written and mental methods for addition and subtraction, before moving on to multiplication and division strategies. Practical problem-solving, maths quizzes, and reasoning tasks will help children apply their skills in fun and engaging ways.

# English - George's Marvellous Medicine

This term, we will be studying George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl. Children will explore the author's life, develop their comprehension skills, and respond creatively through character and setting descriptions. They will learn key grammar features such as fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, and imperative verbs, before producing their own extended narrative inspired by the text.

#### Science - What's that Sound?

This term, the children will investigate how sounds are made and how vibrations travel through different materials. Children will explore pitch and volume, finding patterns between the sounds produced and the objects that create them. They will carry out practical experiments to test and record their findings.

#### RE- God's Call

We will learn about
Abraham's faith in God and
reflect on what it means to
be called by God. Children
will read Bible stories and
take part in discussions and
activities to show
understanding.

### Cooking & Nutrition

Children will prepare and cook simple healthy savoury dishes using safe techniques such as chopping, mixing, and grating.

#### PSHE- Being me in my own world

We will think about our role in the class team and how attitudes and actions affect others.
Children will reflect on how it feels to be included or excluded, set personal goals.

#### Music

Children will be singing with Mr Bruce and African drumming with Michael.
They will learn rhythm, pulse, and performance through practical musicmaking.

## TOPIC- National Park

We will learn where the Lake District is and what makes it special. Children will use maps and atlases to explore its physical and human features and discuss why National Parks are protected..
